### UPR Total Pendency finished at 25.3 months

 compare to FY 2015 26.6 months (FY 2017: Current up to Feb. 2017 - 25.6 months)

Allowance rate finished at approximately 57% (FY 2017: Current up to Feb. 2017 51%)



### FY 2016 Filings

- Total UPR filings up 5.1%
  - Serialized filings up 1.6% (418,506 filings)
  - RCE filings up 13.6% (190,049 filings)
- Prioritized Examination filings up 7.8% (10,011 filings)
- Design filings up 7.1% (40,406 filings)
- Provisional filings down 1.9%
