 - o Start of cost recovery Regulation § 1.167(a)-10(b)
 - o Bonus depreciation wind down (current law)
 - o Investment credits
 - o Tax Re form

Placed in Service - Definition

- Regulation § 1.167(a)-11(e)(1)(i) —
 "Property is first placed in service when first placed in a condition or state of readiness and availability for a specifically assigned function..."
 - o Also se e Prop. Reg. § 1.168-2(l)(2)
 - Similar placed in service rules for investment tax credit purposes...Regulation § 1.46-3(d)
