2018 PRIMARIES: OUTCOMES

- 1M voted in the Democratic Primary and 1.5M voted in the Republican Primary (Runoff Elections May 22nd)
- Incumbents defeated or not seeking reelection 21 (18 Reps; 3 Senators)
- Runoffs:
 - Gov: Lupe Valdez vs Andrew White
 - 1 State Senate seat
 - 17 congressional races
 - 14 State House seats
