- State Level: Local Government Code Chapter 211
 - Municipal Zoning Authority
 - Sections 211.008 211.111 & 211.114
- City Level
 - Zoning Ordinance
 - Unified Development Code
 - Local Rules of Procedure

HOUSEKEEPING: COMPOSITION OF THE BOARD

- Appointment: Governing Body may provide appointment procedure
 - At least five (5) members
 - Two (2) year terms
- Removal: Appointing authority may remove a member for cause
- · Vacancy: Filled for unexpired term
- Alternate Members may be appointed in same manner.
- Type A General Law City: Governing Body may serve as ZBA.
- Panels: Cities over 500,000 may create multiple ZBA panels which can each act as a ZBA.



HOUSEKEEPING: BASIC BOARD PROCEDURES

- Quorum: 75% of membership
- Open Meetings: All meetings are open to the public.
- Records:
 - Minutes must be kept and record member's votes explicitly.
 - · Keep records of examinations and other official actions.
 - Minutes and records shall be filed immediately in the board's office
 - Public records
- Board must adopt procedural rules. Must be approved by governing body.
- Presiding officer may administer oaths and compel the attendance of witnesses.
