



## **HOUSE BILL 347**

- Essentially no more unilateral annexation, (some left, but not what you wanted)
- No more "Tiers"

#### What we are left with:

- 1. "Consent-exempt" annexations
- 2. "Consent" annexations
- 3. "Grandfathered" annexations"

# HOUSE BILL 4257 2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

- · Applies to election approved annexations
- If not approved, City still obligated to provide certain services (Example: water/wastewater regardless of CCN)
- · Limitations on charging higher water rates
