Very difficult		Difficult	Fairly difficult	Plain English	Fairly easy	Easy	Very easy

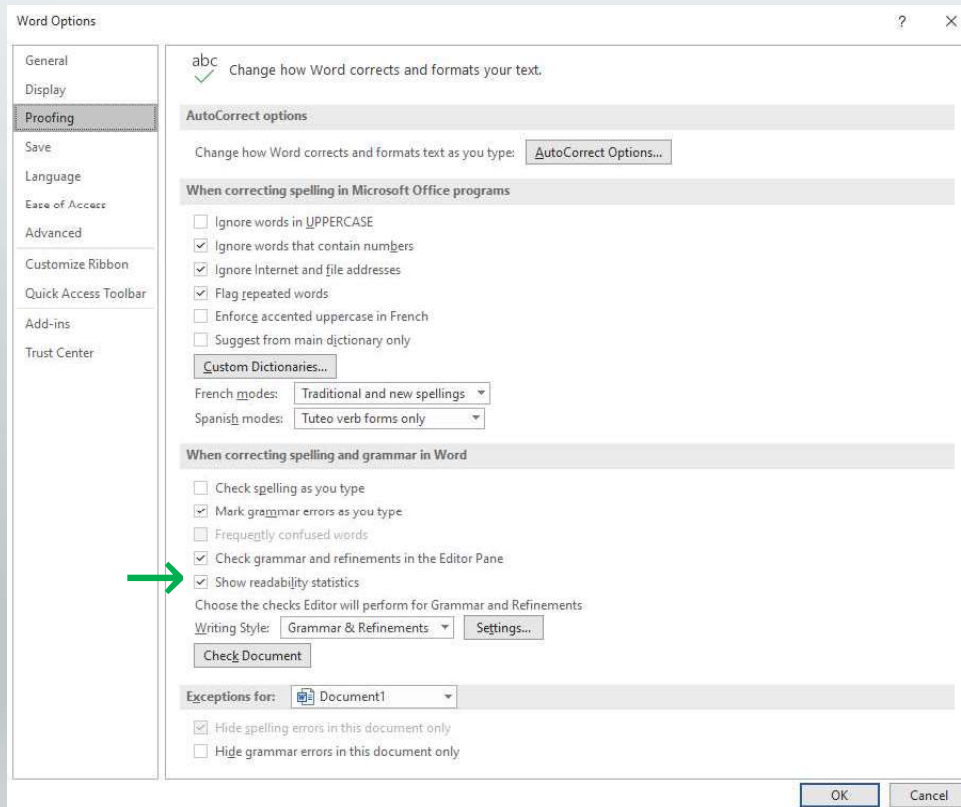

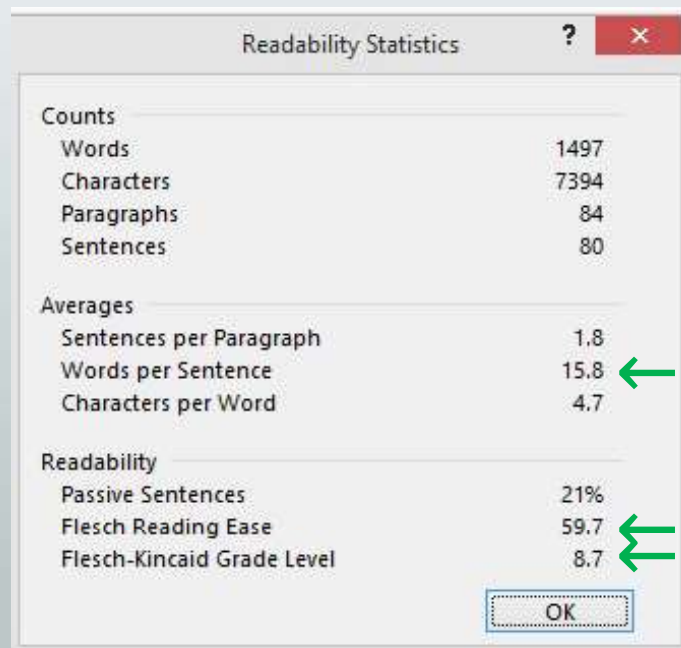
Grade level

- Flesch Kincaid Grade Level
- Assigns a score corresponding to a grade level:
 - How many years of formal education are required for a person to understand the text?
- 12 = completed high school
- 16 = completed college
- 19 = completed law school
- 42 = ?
