

About a quarter of a mile you will see the Centennial Club on the left, sitting all by itself.

• From the Airport/Hilton Hotel, turn right on Airways, right on Airport and right into the Biggs Field Gate.

• From the Inn at Fort Bliss (Marshall Gate), turn right on Fred Wilson, get into the left-hand lane and turn left into the Biggs Field Gate.
