Article VI.A – The Initial Well

This is the project that brought the parties together.

Most of the details were negotiated before the JOA was signed

Article VI.A – The Initial Well

The Initial Well is Obligatory

The only details in the agreement are:

- The location

- The objective depth or formation

- The date by which drilling will begin

Article VI.A – The Initial Well

After the Initial Well begins drilling,
everything else is either:

- a subsequent operation, or
- is excluded from the agreement.
