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What Is A Special Purpose District?

“These districts are areas of the state, county, municipality, or other political subdivision that have been divided for judicial, political, electoral, or administrative purposes. Special purpose districts were originally created due to urban sprawl and the desire of suburban residents to create entities that could provide their own infrastructure and levy taxes for limited purposes, such as firefighting, road construction, and water and sewage treatment.”

What Benefit Do District's Offer?

1. Provide a quality or quantity of development that will not occur without district creation
2. Provide desirable growth and expansion of the tax base without increasing taxes or costs to existing customers
3. Offset City costs to extend infrastructure
4. Assess the users of the infrastructure for the cost of the infrastructure
