# Recall: Legal Ownership of Resources

- Private Ownership (ex. US and Canada)
  - Common Law
    - Surface rights vs. mineral rights
- Sovereign/State Ownership (ex. most jurisdictions)
  - Common Law (ex. UK)
  - Civil Law
  - Domanial (feudal) Law
  - Islamic/Shari'ah Law
    - Intervention of the state is required in order to acquire natural resources
    - State is "trustee" of community property of the people
- Regalian System
  - Ownership based on discovery
    - Right of discovery
    - License to explore (to discover)
