

## FAIR USE DOCTRINE


Developed by courts as a means of balancing the public's interest in the development of arts, science, and history with the copyright owner's exclusive rights.



## FOUR FACTOR TEST

- × Purpose and character of the use
- × Nature of the copyrighted work
- × Amount and substantiality of the portion used
- Effect of the use on the market for or value of the work used
