14th AMENDMENT DUE PROCESS

- Although not explicitly stated in the text of the Constitution, in 1890 the then-to-be Justice Louis Brandeis extolled 'a right to be left alone.' This right has developed into a liberty of personal autonomy protected by the 14th amendment. The Constitutional right of privacy has developed alongside a statutory right of privacy which limits access to personal information

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
