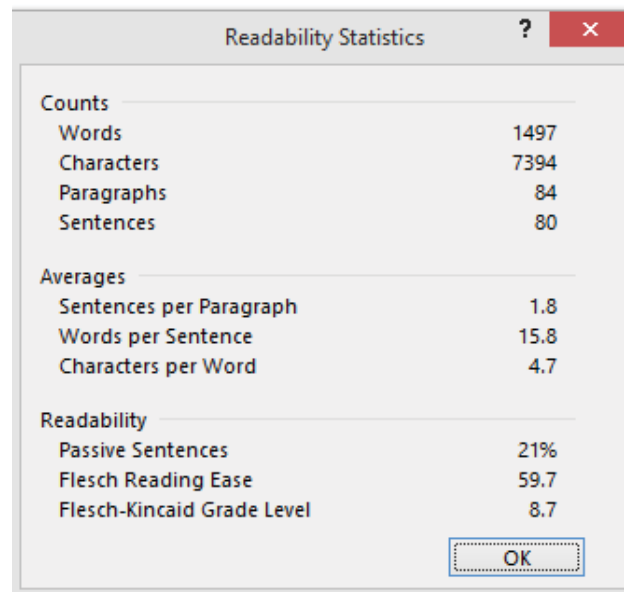

## How do I know my average sentence length?

**Microsoft Word can tell you.**

1. File > Options > Proofing > *When correcting spelling and grammar in Word*
2. Check > *Show readability statistics*
3. You must also check > *Check grammar with spelling*

You'll get a grammar check with every spell check, but you could disable that by going to Settings and unchecking all the grammar settings.
