- Neutral, independent administrative hearings panel for the State
- Mission: Provide fair, efficient hearings process, Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR)
- Created in 1991
- Governed by Gov't Code Chapter 2003



SOAH's Work

- Contested cases under the APA (Gov't Code Chapter 2001)
 where agency does not employ internal hearings officer
- Additional cases and ADR as required or permitted by law
- Serves 50+ agencies (state and local)
- FY 2017: Disposed of 29,000+ cases
