



(b) Have been **charged with any criminal offense**, where such charge has not been resolved;

(c) Have committed <u>acts that constitute a chargeable criminal offense;</u>


(d) Have engaged in fraud or willful misrepresentation in connection


with any official matter or application before a governmental agency;

(e) Have <u>abused</u> any program related to <u>receipt of public benefits;</u>

(f) Are <u>subject to a final order of removal</u>, but who have not complied with their legal obligation to depart the United States; or

(g) **In the judgment of an immigration officer**, otherwise pose a risk to public safety or national security.
