3 Basic Types of Compensatory Damages

- (1) **Time losses**. The plaintiff can recover lost wages or the value of any lost time or earning capacity where injuries prevent work.
- (2) **Expenses** incurred by reason of the injury. These are usually medical expenses and kindred items.
- (3) **Pain and suffering** in its various forms, including emotional distress and consciousness of loss.
