Planning with Trusts

- Trust law is comprised of many moving parts
- Some trusts are more basic & some extremely complex
- In order to understand SNTs, one must know:
 - The basic principles of trust law
 - The public benefit program rules
 - How the program rules and statutes affect trust planning
- Each principle discussed in this section applies to SNTs

Planning with Trusts

- Who **creates** the trust?
- What is the **legal basis** governing the creation of the trust?
- When does the trust become **effective**?
- Who is the intended **beneficiary**?
- What type of **benefits** is the trust providing?
- What are the **distribution** considerations?
- The answers to these questions are determined by the specific goals that we are trying to achieve for our client
