(How We Got Here)

MAKING HISTORY

- California is the first U.S. state to enact comprehensive data protection legislation with passage of CCPA.
 - Who: California Residents
 - What: "GDPR-like" rights of access and control for individuals.
 - When: Effective January 1, 2020*
 - How: California Constitution's "inalienable" right of privacy
 - Why: Response to Cambridge Analytica scandal

TIMEFRAME. IMPACT. ISSUES.

- Timeframe: California lawmakers unanimously passed CCPA in less than a <u>week</u> to avoid passage of a more stringent law.
- Impact: Imposes significant obligations and restrictions on businesses across the U.S. that handle the personal information of California residents.
- Issues: Includes drafting errors and ambiguities due to the speed with which the legislation made its way to the governor.
