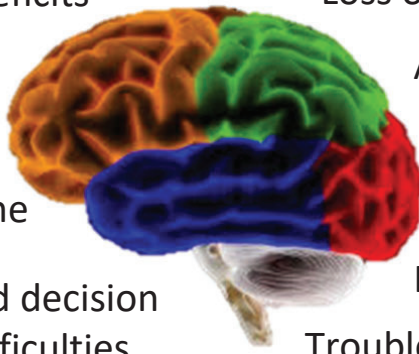

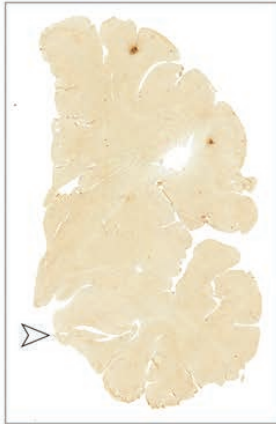

Stage I CTE



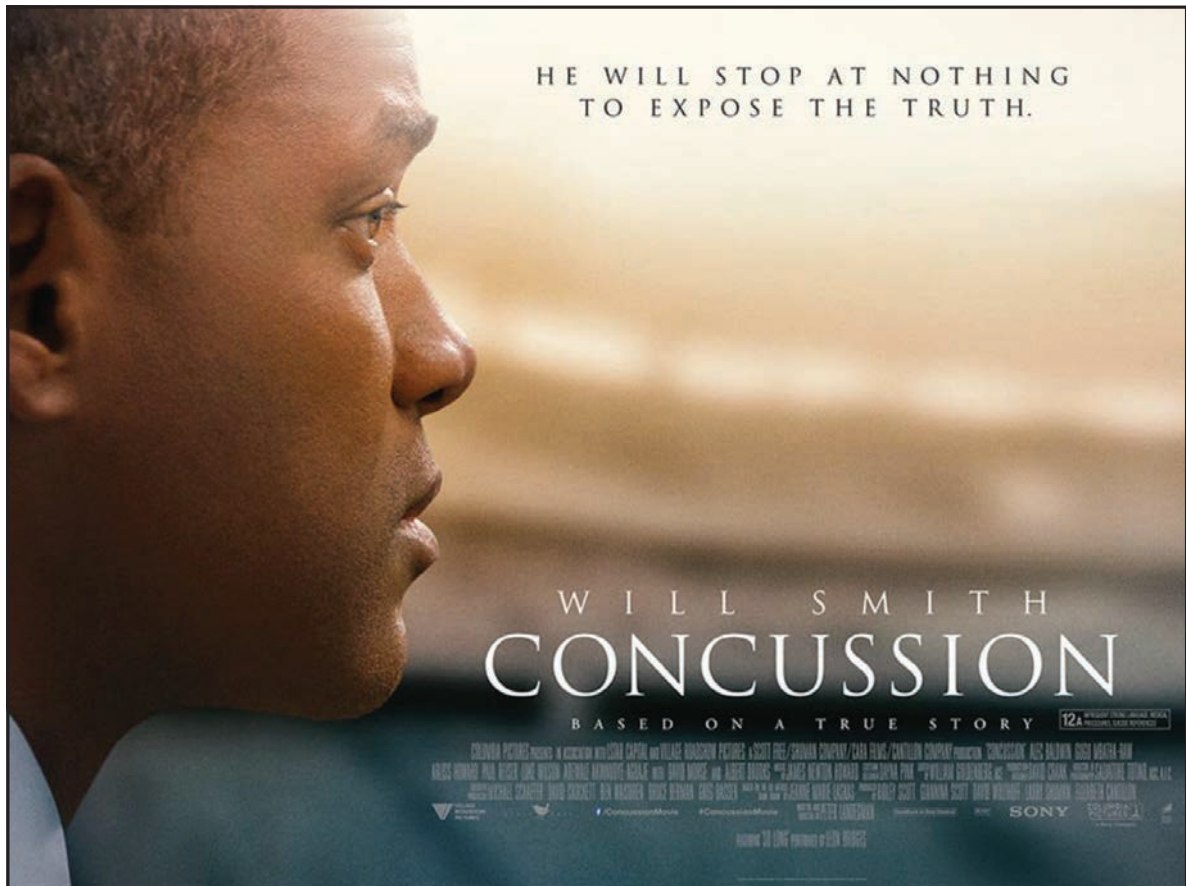
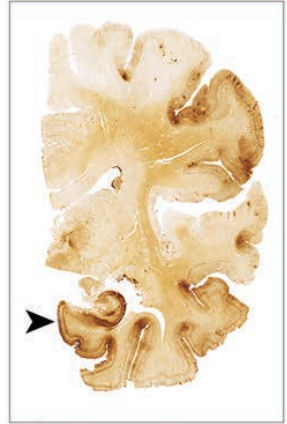
Stage II CTE
