SENATE 26-5

HB 2439 prohibits a governmental entity from enforcing a regulation prohibiting, directly or indirectly, the use or installation of a product or standard permitted in the last three code cycles.

The bill applies to residential and commercial buildings, new construction and remodeling.

This will encompass all existing or proposed restrictions in base zoning, planned development (PD) districts or any density and zoning incentives that favor the use of a particular product or construction method.

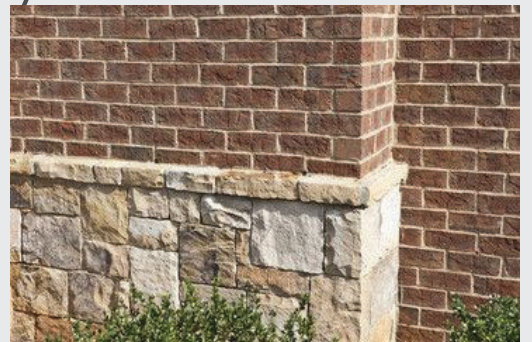
