Quality of life principles

1. Enhance well-being within a cultural context
2. Use a rights-based framework
3. Incorporate financial constraints
4. Promote self-determination
5. Provide individualized supports

Goals

- Enhance beneficiaries' sense that they are valued
- Enhance beneficiaries' appreciation of life despite constraints
- Balance needs for care, safety, and autonomy

Trust standards

- Quality of life considerations are consistent with:
 - the usual trust standards
 - commonly-used trust terms
