- Standard Essential Patents ("SEPs") Patents that must be practiced in order to implement a standard
 - Whether optional or alternative features in standards are SEPs depends on definitions in standards as well as interpretation during litigation
- FRAND Fair Reasonable and Non Discriminatory licensing terms
