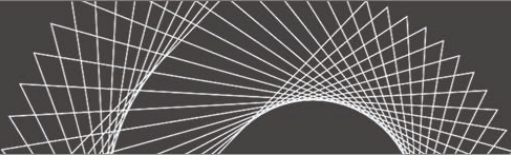

## Shifting Sands

- Since the end of the Cold War, the primary national security objective of export controls has been relatively straight-forward, which is (in essence) to regulate:
  - Weapons of mass destruction;
  - Conventional military items; and
  - Commodities, software, and technology that had some identifiable relationship to their development, production, or use
- The foreign policy objectives of U.S. export controls has been primarily focused on regulating a relatively small number of basic items used in human rights abuses or that support U.S. sanctions, such as those against Iran, Cuba, Syria, the Crimea region of Ukraine, and North Korea.

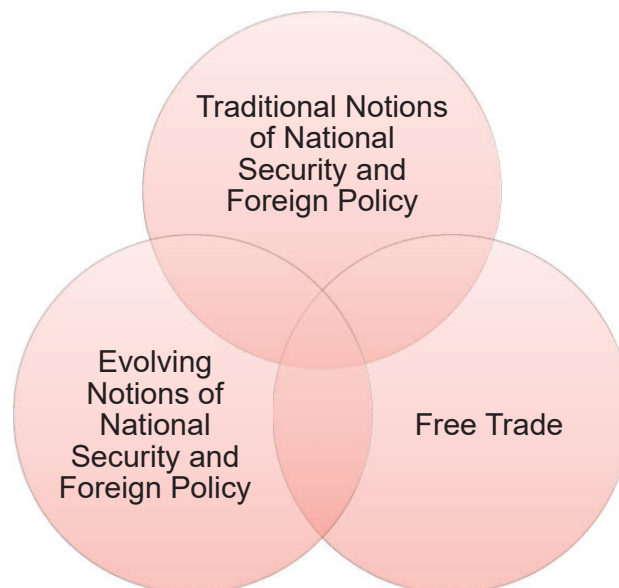
## Shifting Sands
