

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Applicability Criteria (On a dark desert highway...)

A for-profit entity that collects consumers' personal information, determines purposes and means of processing consumers' personal information, conducts business in California, and satisfies at least one of following thresholds:

- Has annual gross revenues in excess of \$25 million;
- Annually buys, receives for its commercial purposes, sells, or shares for commercial purposes, the personal information of 50,000 or more consumers, households, or devices; or
- Derives 50% or more of annual revenue from selling consumers' personal information.
