## Overview of Governing Laws

- Intensely regulated industry due to market crash in 1929
- Federal Law
  - · Securities Act of 1933
  - Securities Exchange Act of 1934
  - JOBS Act (2012)
- State Blue Sky Laws
  - Different in all 50 states
  - · May be subject to several jurisdictions

#### Structure of the Acts

- Securities Act of 1933
  - Rules generally listed as Regulation A, C, D, etc. in 100 format, ex. Rule 415 of Reg. C
  - Forms begin with letternumber format, ex. S-1
  - "Dual act" rules such as
     Regulation F-D and
     Regulation M-A generally
     use Securities Act 100
     format, ex. Rule 100 of All Marketon Proceedings
- Securities Exchange Act of 1934
  - Rules generally listed as reference to Exchange Act section-number format, ex. Rule 10b-5
  - Forms begin with number, ex. 10-K
