


## AIPN Model contracts context

- > Broad participation and input from across AIPN membership
- Seek to reflect current industry practices, both current and evolving
- > Evolve over time as industry practice evolves
- Not necessarily designed to solve all problems or to address all situations/circumstances, but offers options and alternatives to fit the needs of the parties
- > Always seek advice of local counsel

- Identify major differences between Conventional Resource Operations and Unconventional Resource Operations
- > Separate Granting Instrument Issues from Operating Agreement Issues
- ➤ Identify provisions in 2012 Model JOA for modification
- > Discuss and draft modifications
- Conform form and style to AIPN Model Contract Handbook
- Prepare Guidance Notes
