- **Level 3 – Damages and Trial**
 - Causation Medical Proof
 - Damage witnesses

 - Employee Witnesses
 - Supervisors
- **Level 3 – Damages and Trial**
 - Treating medical providers
 - Damage witnesses



Think of Priorities

- **Level 1 – Essential Liability**
 - Defendant Care Providers
- **Level 2 – Supplemental Liability**
 - Supervisors for Policy and Procedures
 - Collateral care providers
- **Level 3 – Damages and Trial**
 - Subsequent treaters
 - Adverse Experts
