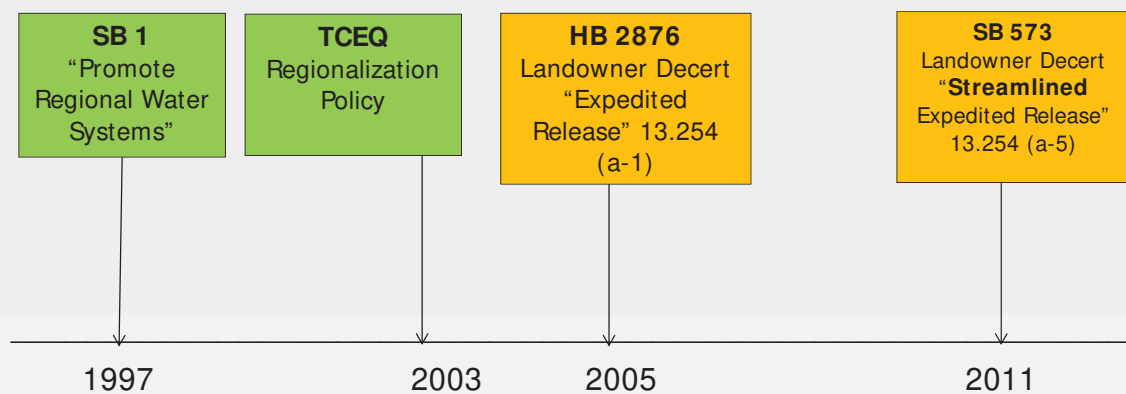

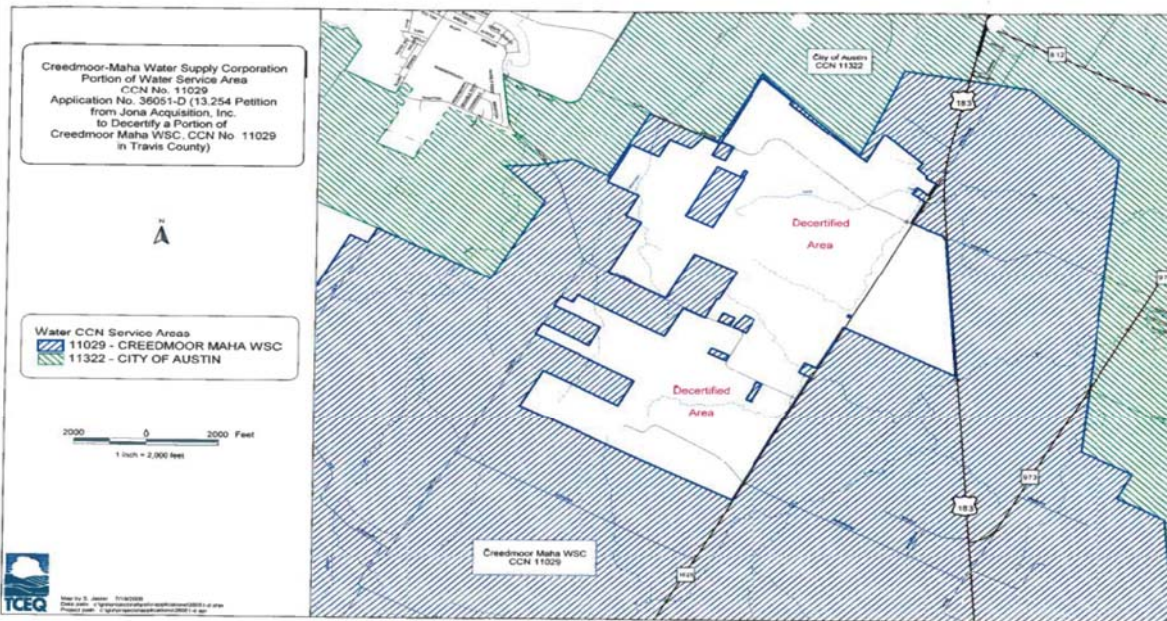

Fragmentation of CCN Areas

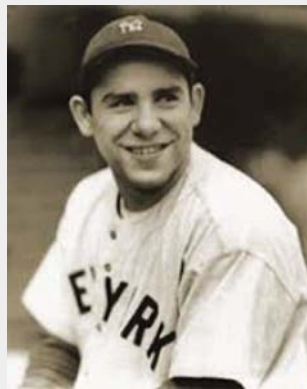
Release of Land from Creedmoor-Maha WSC

Streamlined Expedited Release Water Code 13.254(a-5)

- **Thresholds**

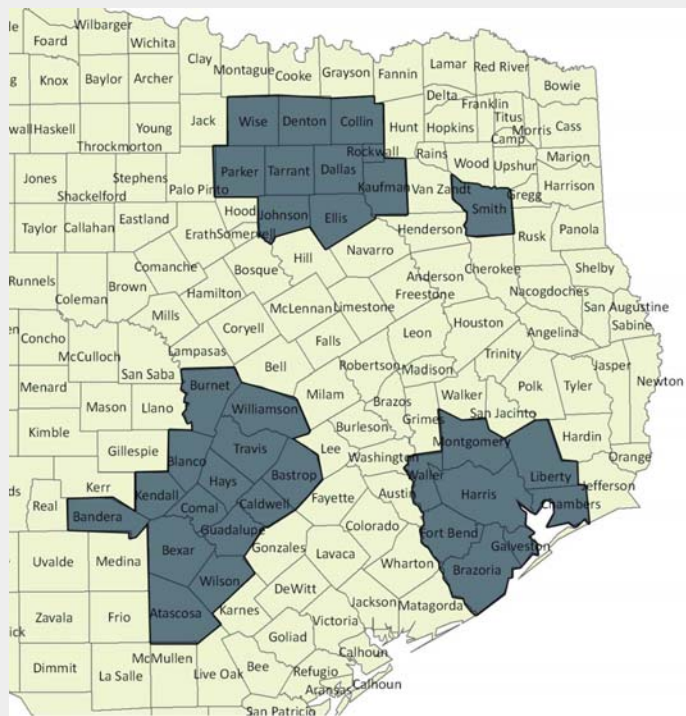
- Within the 33 Counties
- Tract of Land 25 Acres, or more
- Not Receiving Water/Sewer Service

- **Process**

- Landowner Petition to PUC
- Legal Description/Ownership
- “Shall Grant” w/in 60 Days
