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

- Financial Incentives
 - · Medical Data more Valuable than Credit Card Data
 - Fraud
 - · order expensive drugs or equipment for resale
 - file made-up claims with insurance companies and get money in return.
 - · seek free medical care under another's identity.
- · Competitive Data
 - · Practice Management Software
 - · Effectiveness of Therapies
 - · Patient Lists
 - · Mortality Rates

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Hackable Medical Devices

- · Medical Devices are usually Wi-Fi enabled
 - · More than half of devices in America are software-enabled
- Unintentional Breaches
 - X-Ray Machines hit with viruses
 - Radiotherapy machine kills 5 due to software bug
- BARNABY JACK
 - · hack into a pacemaker via Wi-Fi
 - · send an 830-volt shock through a person's body
 - · Can be done with a laptop from 30 to 50 feet away
 - · Demonstrated talk at Breakpoint security conference in Melbourne, Australia
 - Also able to access personal data stored on implants, such as confidential patient information and the doctor's name

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
