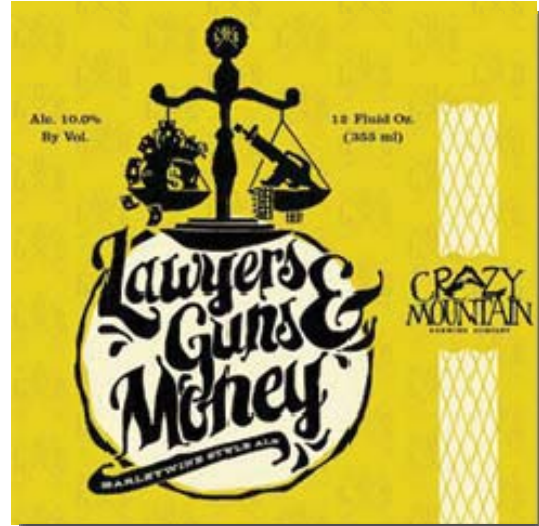

## How did we get here?

- 1871 – Texas bans carrying pistols
- 1976 – GA joins VT, NH, WA, CT
- 1987 – FL becomes 7<sup>th</sup> “shall issue”
- 1994 – AL, AZ, TN, & WY total 20
- 1995 – Texas and six others
- 2011 – Iowa becomes 49<sup>th</sup>
- 2012 – 7<sup>th</sup> Cir. overrules Illinois ban

## 7 Serious political spending



In the two-year 2014 election cycle, the NRA's political arm spent nearly **\$36 million** on lobbying, campaign contributions and other political spending.

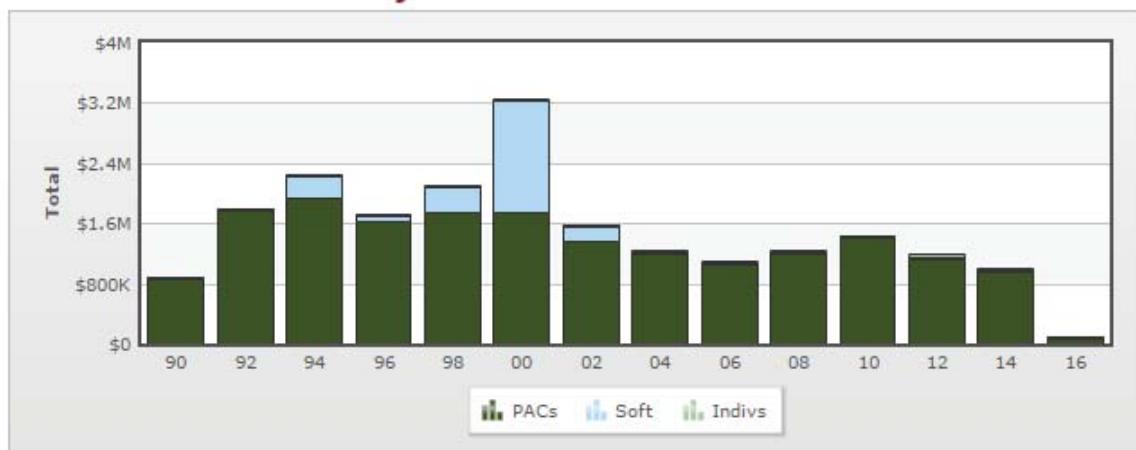
