

- 1871 Texas bans carrying pistols
- 1976 GA joins VT, NH, WA, CT
- 1987 FL becomes 7th "shall issue"
- 1994 AL, AZ, TN, & WY total 20
- 1995 Texas and six others
- 2011 Iowa becomes 49th
- 2012 7th Cir. overrules Illinois ban






In the two-year 2014 election cycle, the NRA's political arm spent nearly **\$36 million** on lobbying, campaign contributions and other political spending.
