- Organizational scheme
- Signposting

Organizational scheme

- Organizational scheme is the way the document is broken into pieces.
- The organizational scheme should reflect the law.

For example, negligence:

A discussion of negligence could be broken into:

- Duty
- Breach
- Cause
- Harm

But would this work?
