Not Just Another Witness

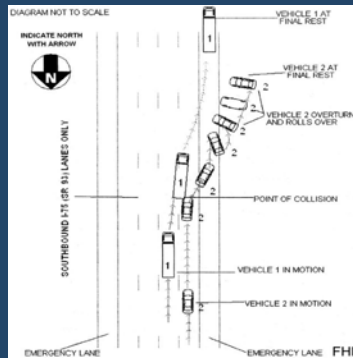
- Often, single most important factor for: 1) P's attorneys, 2) risk managers, 3) adjusters, and ...

Admissibility of Police Reports



Admissibility of Police Reports

- Requires reports for MVA's when: 1) Injury or death, or 2) Property damage > \$1,000.
- Usually admissible as TRE 803(8) public records.
- Sometimes admissible as TRE 803(6) business records.
