WHAT IS A MUNIMENT OF TITLE?

- Unique to Texas
- Transfers title to real and personal property without the necessity of a formal administration
- Decedent must have left a valid Will
- No execute or administrator appointed/No Letters issued

REQUIREMENTS

- The Decedent's estate must not have any creditors other than debts secured by real estate.
- There is no other necessity for the administration of the Estate.
