- Have access to the company's network.

1. Managing Vendor Risk

To mitigate risks:

- · Conduct thorough due diligence
- Draft contracts that address risks with:
 - Appropriate representations and warranties
 - Audit rights
 - Required ongoing training
 - Strong notice provisions
 - Insurance requirements
 - Indemnity provisions
