- But not government

DMA - Application

- Applies to claim for relief, however characterized, from damages arising out of harm to <u>personal reputation</u> caused by false content of a publication.
- Applies to all publications in any form

Prerequisite to Suit for Defamation

- DMA establishes a timely and sufficient request for correction, clarification, or retraction as prerequisite to "maintain an action for defamation."
- Demand is timely if made within SOL
- 90 days after learning of publication deadline to demand retraction to recover exemplary damages
