## Yes, Texas has DPR

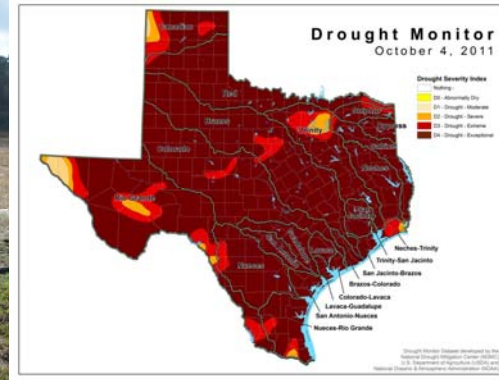


- Texas has the only operating DPR plant in the U.S. Colorado River Municipal Water District has been in operation for 3 years

- Many other PWSs have expressed interest...

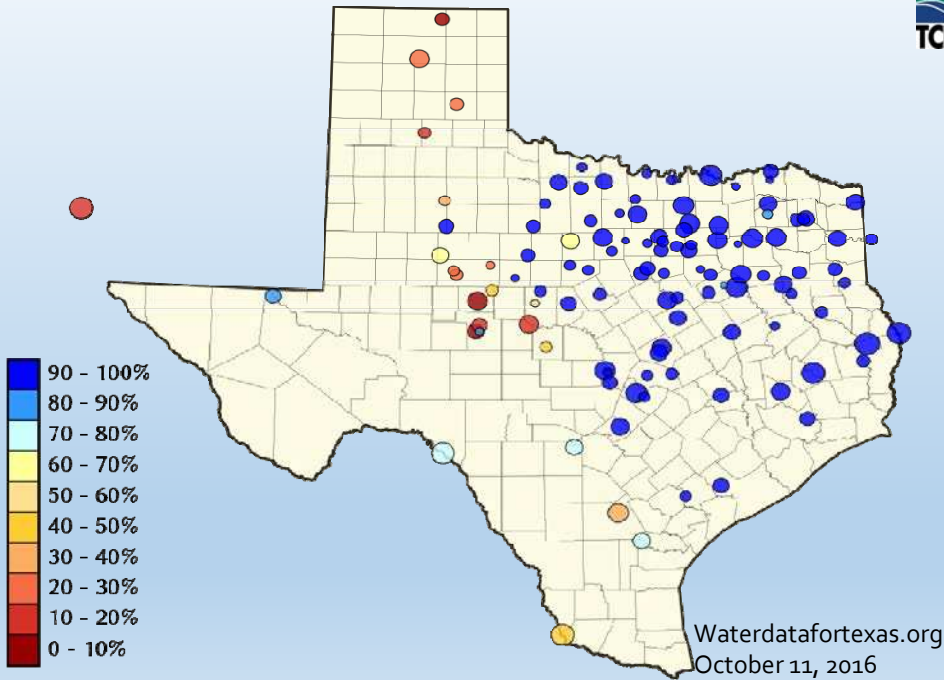
# Drivers for DPR in Texas



First there was Statewide drought



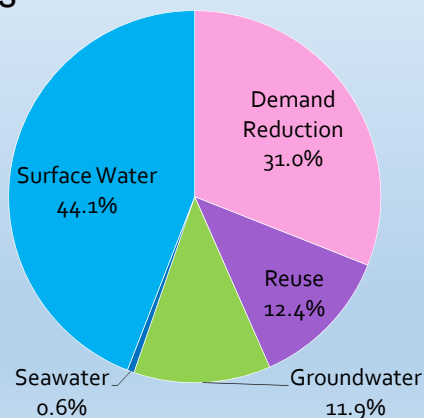
# Then it Rained in Parts of Texas
