Yes, Texas has DPR

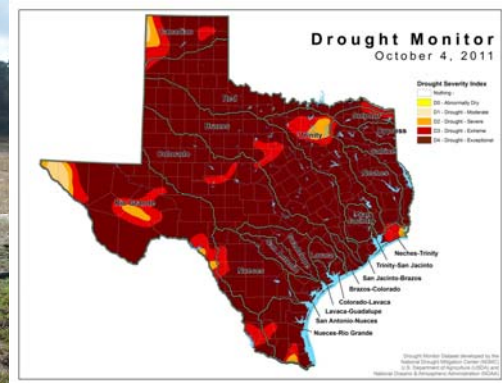


- Texas has the only operating DPR plant in the U.S. Colorado River Municipal Water District has been in operation for 3 years
- Wichita Falls operated for 1 year
- El Paso PWS completed pilot testing
- Many other PWSs have expressed interest...

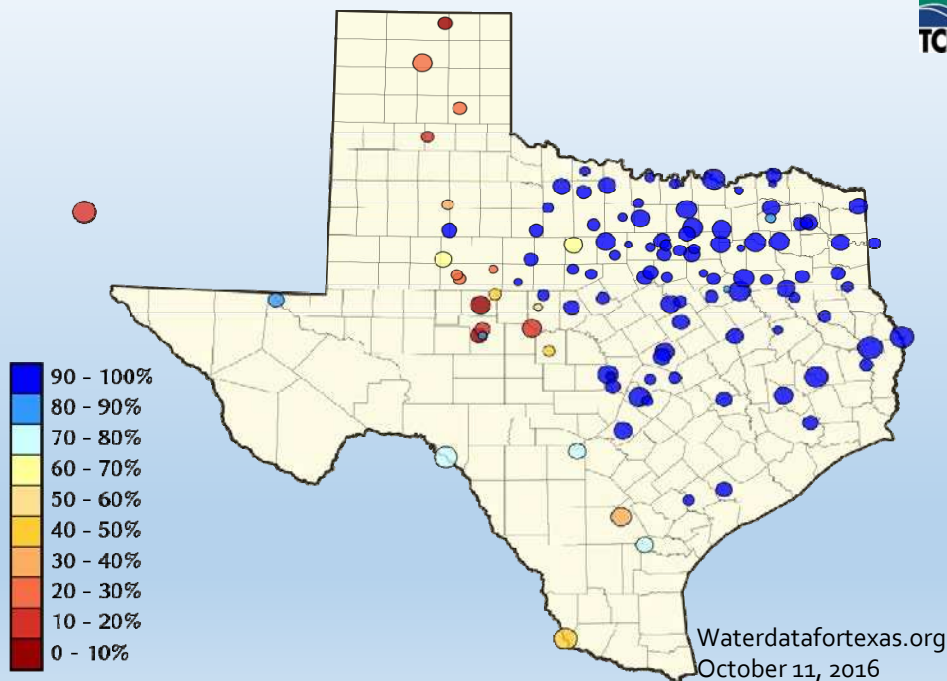
Drivers for DPR in Texas



First there was Statewide drought



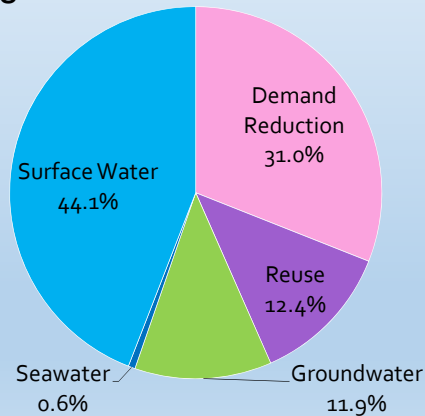
Then it Rained in Parts of Texas
