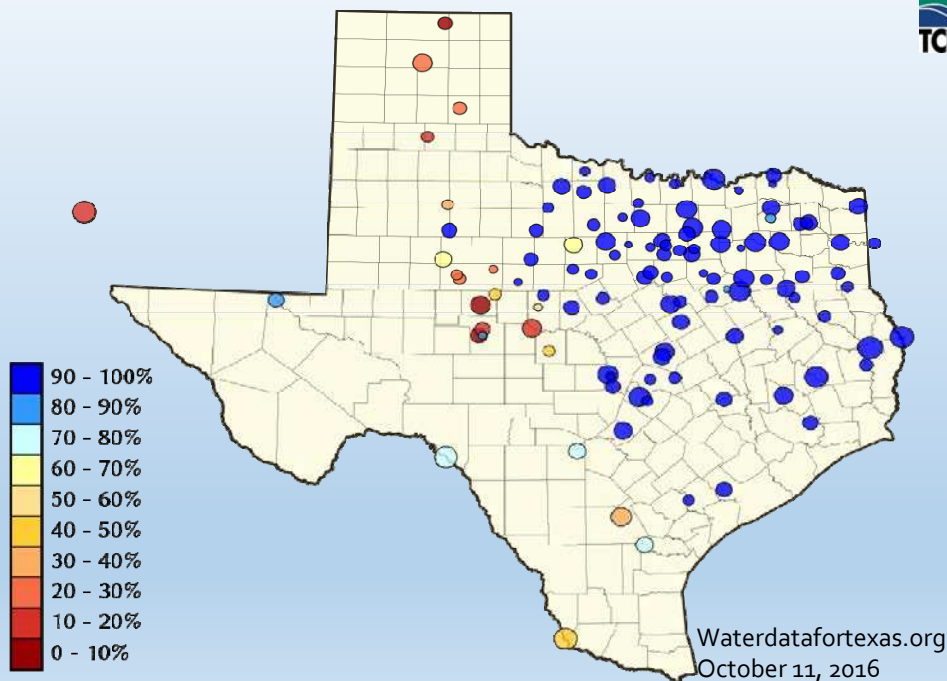
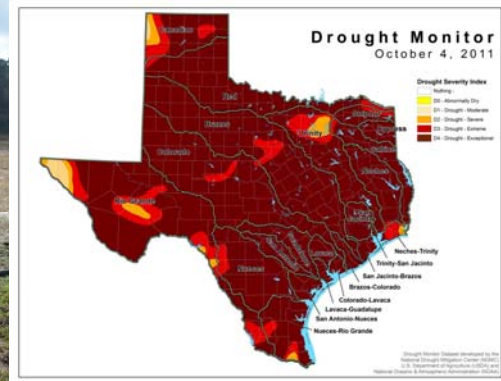

Yes, Texas has DPR



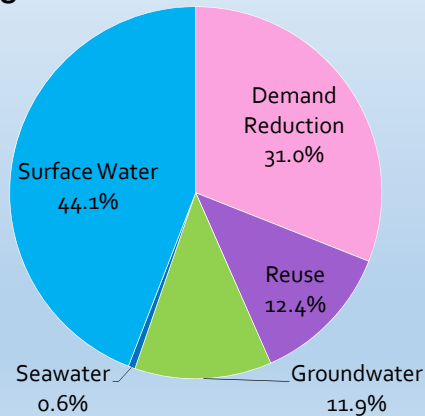
- Texas has the only operating DPR plant in the U.S. Colorado River Municipal Water District has been in operation for 3 years
- Wichita Falls operated for 1 year
- El Paso PWS completed pilot testing
- Many other PWSs have expressed interest...



State Wide Water Planning



- Texas Water Development Board develops the state water plan
- Based on 16 regional plans
- 50 year planning period
- Strategy Supplies Breakdown: 2030
