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## Oil and Gas Leases

A lease is a lease, of course, of course, And no one can say otherwise of course. That is, of course, unless the lease is

. . . a conveyance of a real property interest.



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Oil and Gas Leases

- Why does it matter?
- Bankruptcy Code Section 365(d)(4):
  - 120-day period to assume or reject unexpired leases
  - Deadline can be extended for up to an additional 90 days by court order
  - Any extension beyond 210 days requires consent of lessor
  - If unexpired lease is not assumed within applicable time period, lease is deemed rejected and debtor shall immediately surrender property to the lessor
- Assumption requires cure

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## Oil and Gas Leases

- Real property interests under Texas, Oklahoma, and New Mexico law
  - Not subject to assumption or rejection under Section 365
  - Can be sold free and clear of liens and claims under Section 363
- · Real property interests under North Dakota law
  - Great Plains Royalty Corp., affirmed real property interest
  - No determination on Section 365



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#### Oil and Gas Leases

- Less clear and unsettled in other states, particularly where there is not long history of oil and gas production
  - Louisiana
  - Pennsylvania
- Executory Contracts Subject to Section 365 in:
  - Kansas
  - Ohio
  - New York
- Federal law
  - May be executory contracts, subject to assumption or rejection
  - Transfer of leases requires DOI approval
