




   L. Hunt; managed by Hunter L. Hunt






Competitive Renewable Energy Zone (CREZ)

Update

- Original Sharyland CREZ Designation
  - ~300 miles of facilities in Texas Panhandle and South Plains, consisting of:
    - Five 345kV transmission lines
    - Four collection stations
  - Completed in 2013
- A.J. Swope Station added in 2014
- White River and Abernathy Stations added in 2016
- PUCT approved CCN for second circuit around Amarillo under CREZ Order (PURA §39.904(g)
  - Under construction
  - To be completed Q2, 2018
