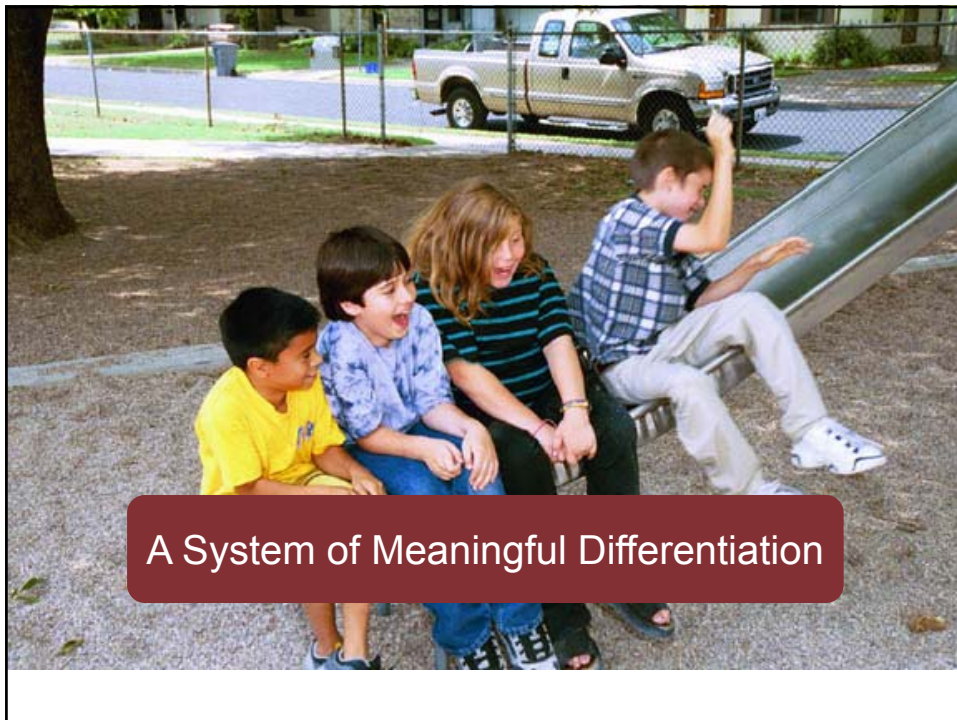

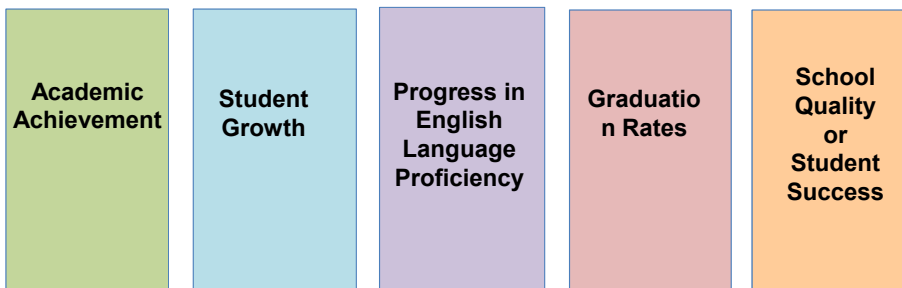


Overview of Transition Dates
