ZONING APPEALS

Changes in the zoning of a particular tract or area

- a landowner appeals a denial
- a neighbor appeals a grant

Changes in zoning regulations

- rarely the subject of litigation
- maybe not a zoning case at all

EXHAUSTION OF REMEDIES

Zoning Commission (aka Plan Commission)

- no statutory power to change zoning
- therefore a challenge to the commission's decision is not ripe
- its power is nevertheless greater than that of an advisory commission

EXHAUSTION OF REMEDIES

City Council

- its decision will be final
- no further administrative appeals available
- * so ripe for appeal

Board of Adjustment

- argument has been made that an exception should be applied for
- have seen no cases where a challenge to a zoning change or denial was dismissed for ripeness on this basis
