## Municipal Zoning Regulations Texas Local Government Code Chapter 211

· 211.001 Purpose

"The powers granted under this subchapter are for the purpose of promoting the public health, safety, morals, or general welfare and protection and preserving places and areas of historical, cultural, or architectural importance and significance."

211.013(b) Exceptions

"This subchapter does not authorize the governing body of a municipality to require the removal or destruction of property that exists at the time the governing body implements this subchapter and that is actually and necessarily used in a public service business."

### What are Nonconformities

 Under the common law, a non-conforming use of land or buildings is a use that existed legally when the zoning restriction became effective and has continued to exist. <u>City</u> <u>of University Park v. Benners</u>, 485 S.W.2d 773 (Tex. 1972)



### Regulation of Non Conforming Situations

- <u>Permitting</u> nonconformities to continue as long as all other code provisions are met requires registration application
- <u>Replacement</u> of nonconformities which are potentially undesirable and incompatible with surrounding conforming uses and require compliance with all other the regulations
- <u>Prohibiting expansions</u> of nonconformities unless required by law to meet minimum health and safety requirements required by government entity
- <u>Termination</u> of nonconformities resulting from destruction or abandonment
