- Me xic o Energy Re form
 - Constitutionalamendments in December of 2013 establish new industry rules for oil, naturalgas, and electricity.
 - This sweeping reform of the energy sector brings an end to the long standing control the state monopolies have had.
 - Provides a competitive and transparent energy market that is attractive to foreign investment.




KEY PLAYERS IN THE ENERGY REFORM


- PEMEX Mexican state owned petroleum company. Historically responsible for all aspects of the petroleum industry in Mexico.
- CFE Me xic an state owned electric utility. Responsible for the operation and development of the electric industry in Me xic o. Responsible for most of the new pipeline build out to supply electric generation facilities.
- CENEGAS Me xic an state run company responsible for operating and managing the transportation and storage of naturalgas in Me xico. Inherited over 5,500 miles of pipe lines from Pemex.

PIPELINE CAPACITY TO MEXICO

- Cument capacity of 7 Bc f/d
- Expected to double to 14 Bc f/d in next 2 years
- All new projects originate in Texas
- Changes U.S natural gas supply and demand dynamics
