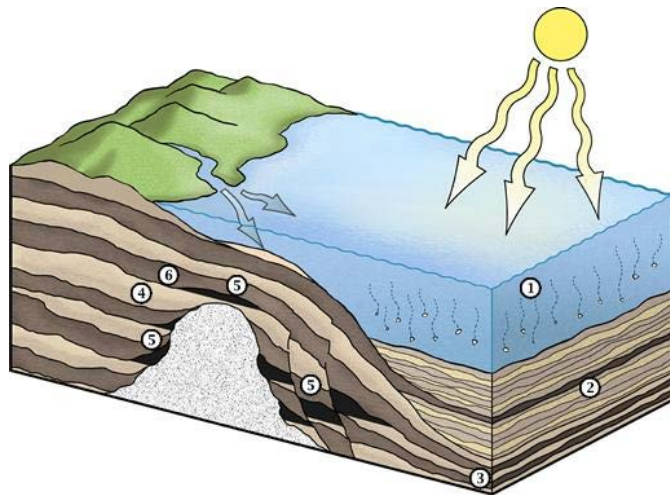
So You Want to Drill a Well?
