 - Congressional Review Act (5 U.S.C. §§ 801-808)
 - · Amend authorizing statutes
 - · Appropriations riders



NOMINATIONS


- Elections select the Decision Makers but "who" does the deciding is determined by the political appointment process
- White House Office of Presidential Personnel
 - Approximately 4000 appointees are not Senate confirmed but serve "at the will" of the President
 - Approximately 1200 require Senate confirmation
 - · Negotiation between Secretaries / White House
 - Vetting Process
 - · Senate Committee Hearings
 - · Vote by the full Senate

- Revise or Rescind
 - Obama Administration Climate Change Policies
- Presidential Memorandum
 - Keystone Pipeline
 - Presidential Permit issued by State on April 4, 2017
 - Dakota Access Pipeline
 - · Corps granted Easement (Feb. 7, 2017)
- Policy Changes through Legal Opinions
 - Issued by Agency General Counsel / Solicitor
 - DOJ's Office of Legal Counsel
