# **National Filings**

- 1st Two Quarters of FY 2017:
- Ch. 13 cases down 2 %
- Ch. 7 cases down 4%
- Ch. 11 down by 13%

# Chapter 7 filings- Local

WDTX- up 5% through April 2017 EDTX up 6% NDTX up 6% SDTX up 20%

# Chapter 13 Filings- Local

WDTX up <1% through April 2017 EDTX up 10% NDTX down 11% SDTX up 5%

## Chapter 11 filings-Local

WDTX down 51% through April 2017 EDTX down 7% NDTX up 176% SDTX up 40%

#### **Means Test**

- FY 2016, the USTP declined to file a motion to dismiss in about 63 percent of presumed abusive cases that didn't voluntarily dismiss or convert to chapter 13.
- In FY 2006 the percentage of declinations was less than 35 percent
- Trend suggests objective criteria of the means test are well established and that counsel file presumed abusive cases primarily when they can satisfy statutory exceptions.
