"FAMILY MEMBERS"

- Related by marriage, blood, or adoption <u>AND</u> living in house
- Spouse covered when divorce pending (Ins. Code)
- Variations in definition of family member in policies; not defined in transp. code or ins. code

Additional Insureds



PERMISSIVE USERS OF INSURED AUTO

 another person who <u>reasonably</u> <u>believes they have permission</u>
