## The 85th Legislative Session



### HB 1290, sec. 1

New APA § 2001.0045 "One In, One Out" Rule

- Exclusions:
  - ► Agency headed by an elected official
  - ▶ DFPS, DMV, PUC, TCEQ, Texas Racing Commission
  - ► Self-directed or semi-independent agency
- Exclusions:
  - ► Rules related to: procurements; natural disasters; federal law/funding match; protect water resources; health, safety and welfare; OR
  - ► Necessary to implement legislation

### HB 1290, sec. 2

New APA § 2001.0221 requires a state agency to prepare a government growth impact statement for each proposed rule.

- Does the rule create or eliminate a government program?
- ▶ Would the implementation of the rule have a positive or negative impact on FTE needs?
- ▶ Would the rule increase the need for GR funding?
- ▶ Would the rule affect the amount of fees?
- ▶ Does the rule create a new regulation?
- ▶ Does the rule expand, limit, or repeal an existing regulation?
- ▶ Does the rule increase or decrease the number of individuals subject to regulation?
- ▶ The positive/ negative impact on the state's economy.

#### HB 3433

The new law amends Texas Government Code ch. 2006: AGENCY ACTIONS AFFECTING SMALL BUSINESSES AND RURAL COMMUNITIES

- ► Each state agency will need to do a separate analysis to describe any adverse fiscal impact of a proposed rule on a municipality with a population of less than 25,000.
- ▶ The proposed rule must include a regulatory flexibility analysis for rural communities.
- Notice of proposed rule must be sent, if feasible, to each member of the legislature who represents a rural community adversely impacted by the proposed rule.

## APA § 2001.038



- ► Procedural Invalidity
  - Failure to Substantially Comply
  - Illegal Rulemaking (non-compliance)
- Substantive Invalidity: Exceeds Statutory Authority
- Applicability: Whether a Rule Applies?
